Gérard Guéniot, M.D., received his medical degree from the L'Université de Lille in 1975 and studied homeopathy and acupuncture at various institutes from 1971 to 1976, including the Centre Homéopathique de France. He is the founder of four homeopathic and two acupuncture schools in Belgium and France, where he directs several teaching programs on homeopathy, acupuncture and traditional Chinese medicine. Dr. Guéniot is recognized as a leading expert in miasmatic drainage, acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine, and he is the author of three books on holistic health. He lectures extensively all over the world and is the foremost authority on the Unda Numbered Compounds. Dr. Guéniot has a holistic center "Renaissance" in Belgium and a medicine practice as M.D. in France. He created the concept of homeopathy of terrain and he is writing 3 books on the Homeopathy of terrain, Phytotherapy and terrain, and Gemmotherapy: Mother Macerates. He is in his tenth year of teaching for Seroyal.

- Demonstrate how to recognize the patient's homeopathic profile using the knowledge of the temperamental and miasmatic approach and how to prescribe homeopathic remedies accordingly
- Analyze the polychrests and satellite remedies belonging to each specific miasm in eight segments and provide you with their practical clinical applications
- Teach the remedies as follows: physiology, psychological profile, picture of remedy, etiological signs, general signs, regional signs, main indications and their place in the terrain

SESSION ONE: LUETIC MIASM

Prior to focusing on the Luetic miasm, Dr. Guéniot will begin with a brief overview of the individual terrains, miasms and temperaments as well as the different homeopathic remedies and the ten major ideas from the Organon. Then, he will examine the Luetic miasm, describing the characteristics of a Luetic patient. He will also show the relationship of the specific homeopathic remedies to this miasm. Dr. Guéniot will explain how homeopathy addresses both acute and chronic pathologies as a dynamic process and how crucial the understanding of case taking and the materia medica are to address acute and chronic pathologies. He will also discuss homeopathy for the Third Age and show you how to put together prescriptions for acute and chronic treatments. He will focus on treatment plans for pathologies generally associated with but not limited to the luetic miasm such as growth disturbances, atherosclerosis, minor traumatologies, sore throats, coughs, sinusitis, otitis, abdominal and gastric pains, stress, chronic suppurations, gastritis, stomach ulcers, anguish, anxiety, neurosis, depression, hypertension, renal insufficiencies and enuresis.

SESSION TWO: TUBERCULINIC MIASM

Dr. Guéniot will begin reviewing, discussing and answering any questions that the participants may have from the previous Luetic course. He will then explore in depth the Tuberculinic miasm, outlining the characteristics typically attributed to Tuberculinic patients and discuss the most common polychrests and satellite remedies associated with the Tuberculinic miasm. Dr. Guéniot will examine the pathologies that are generally associated with but not limited to the Tuberculinic miasm such as hepatitis, thyroid disorders, fever, influenza, rhinopharyngitis, bronchitis, acute and chronic cystitis, acute suppurations, osteoarthritis, small joint conditions and asthma. In addition to discussing aggravations, metastasis, suppurations and the progress in a patient's treatment, he will pay special attention to children's psychopathology, and to how the birth control pill affects the physiology, emotions and spirituality of women.

SESSION THREE: SYCOTIC MIASM

Prior to focusing on the Sycotic miasm, Dr. Guéniot will begin reviewing, discussing and answering any questions that the participants may have from the previous two courses. He will then explore in depth the Sycotic miasm, outlining the characteristics typically attributed to Sycotic patients. This time, he will continue to identify the polychrests and satellite remedies related to the Sycotic miasm. Since the management of pathologies is crucial in healing, Dr. Guéniot will discuss the etiology through to the progression of disease and, consequently, treatment plans. He will then identify the pathologies commonly associated with but not limited to the Sycotic miasm such as polyarthritis, menopause, leukorrhea, varicose veins, phlebitis, eye and mouth conditions, breast, uterine and ovarian pathologies, and puberty-related conditions. He will continue discussing the follow-up of the patient and the accuracy of the prescription. In addition, he will explain the pivotal role homeopathy plays in assisting the patient's final journey to death.

SESSION FOUR: PSORIC MIASM

Dr. Guéniot will begin reviewing, discussing and answering any questions that the participants may have from the previous three courses. He will then examine the Psoric miasm in detail, outlining the characteristics typically attributed to Psoric patients. In this session, Dr. Guéniot will discuss the polychrests and satellite remedies commonly correlated with the Psoric miasm. He will describe the etiology and pathogenesis of the acute and chronic pathologies generally associated with but not limited to the psoric miasm such as chronic colopathy, lithiasis - gall bladder and renal, diarrhea, hemorrhoids, nausea, vomiting, skin eruptions, gout, prostate-related conditions, and chronic skin pathology. He will emphasize the importance of being able to prioritize the treatment according to the hierarchy of the patient illnesses. He will also discuss the integration of homeopathy with other biotherapeutics.
